acpi\_listen - ACPI event listener

## **SYNOPSIS**

acpi\_listen [options]

#### **DESCRIPTION**

acpid is the system-wide ACPI event catcher. acpi\_listen is a simple shell-friendly tool which connects to acpid and listens for events. When an event occurs, acpi\_listen will print it on stdout.

## **OPTIONS**

## -c, --count events

Receive up to a maximum number of ACPI events, then exit.

### -s, --socketfile filename

This option changes the name of the UNIX domain socket which acpid opens. Default is /var/run/acpid.socket.

## -t, --time seconds

-v, --version Print ver

Print version information and exit.

-h, --help

Show help and exit.
