## **DESCRIPTION**

If GnuPG is installed on a system with existing user accounts, it is sometimes required to populate the GnuPG home directory with existing files. Especially a ?trustlist.txt? and a keybox with some initial certificates are often desired. This script helps to do this by copying all files from ?/etc/skel/.gnupg? to the home directories of the accounts given on the command line. It takes care not to overwrite existing GnuPG home directories. addgnupghome is invoked by root as:

addgnupghome account1 account2 ... accountn
