#### NAME

buildah-source-pull - Pull a source image from a registry to a specified path

#### SYNOPSIS

buildah source pull [options] registry path

#### DESCRIPTION

Pull a source image from a registry to a specified path. The pull operation will fail if the image does not comply with a source-image OCI artifact.

Note that the buildah-source command and all its subcommands are experimental and may be subject to future changes.

#### OPTIONS

--creds creds

The [username[:password]] to use to authenticate with the registry if required. If one or both values are not supplied, a command line prompt will appear and the value can be entered. The password is entered without echo.

--tls-verify bool-value

Require HTTPS and verification of certificates when talking to container registries (defaults to true). TLS verification cannot be used when talking to an insecure registry.
