#### NAME

docker-container-export - Export a container's filesystem as a tar archive

## **SYNOPSIS**

docker container export [OPTIONS] CONTAINER

### **DESCRIPTION**

Export the contents of a container's filesystem using the full or shortened con? tainer ID or container name. The output is exported to STDOUT and can be redirected to a tar file.

Stream to a file instead of STDOUT by using -o.

#### **EXAMPLES**

Export the contents of the container called angry\_bell to a tar file called an? gry\_bell.tar:

\$ docker export angry\_bell > angry\_bell.tar

\$ docker export --output=angry\_bell-latest.tar angry\_bell

\$ ls -sh angry\_bell.tar
