

Fully qualified path of the ignition file.

If an ignition file is provided, the file will be copied into the user's CONF_DIR and re-named. Additionally, no SSH keys will be generated nor will a system connection be made. It is assumed that the user will do these things manually or handle otherwise.

`--image-path`

Fully qualified path or URL to the VM image. Can also be set to `testing`, `next`, or `stable` to pull down default image. Defaults to `testing`.

`--memory, -m=number`

Memory (in MB).

`--help`

Print usage statement.

EXAMPLES

```
$ podman machine init
```

```
$ podman machine init myvm
```

```
$ podman machine init --disk-size 50
```

```
$ podman machine init --memory=1024 myvm
```
