docker-service-logs - Fetch the logs of a service or task

SYNOPSIS

docker service logs [OPTIONS] SERVICE|TASK

DESCRIPTION

Fetch the logs of a service or task

OPTIONS

- `--details[=false]` Show extra details provided to logs

- `-f, --follow[=false]` Follow log output

- `-h, --help[=false]` help for logs

- `--no-resolve[=false]` Do not map IDs to Names in output

- `--no-task-ids[=false]` Do not include task IDs in output

`--no-trunc[=false]` Do not truncate output

`--raw[=false]` Do not neatly format logs

`--since=""` Show logs since timestamp (e.g. 2013-01-02T13:23:37Z) or relative (e.g. 42m for 42 minutes)

`-n, --tail="all"` Number of lines to show from the end of the logs

`-t, --timestamps[=false]` Show timestamps
