### NAME

git-prune-packed - Remove extra objects that are already in pack files

### **SYNOPSIS**

git prune-packed [-n|--dry-run] [-q|--quiet]

### **DESCRIPTION**

This program searches the \$GIT\_OBJECT\_DIRECTORY for all objects that currently exist in a pack file as well as the independent object directories.

All such extra objects are removed.

A pack is a collection of objects, individually compressed, with delta compression applied, stored in a single file, with an associated index file.

Packs are used to reduce the load on mirror systems, backup engines, disk storage, etc.

#### **OPTIONS**

-n, --dry-run

Don?t actually remove any objects, only show those that would have been removed.

-q, --quiet

Squelch the progress indicator.
