git sh-i18n--envsubst is Git?s stripped-down copy of the GNU envsubst(1) program that comes with the GNU gettext package. It?s used internally by git-sh-i18n(1) to interpolate the variables passed to the eval\_gettext function.

No promises are made about the interface, or that this program won?t disappear without warning in the next version of Git. Don?t use it.
