

local IFADDR argument or the device in the IFNAME argument. If you would like to connect the port, you can specify the peer address in the peer IFADDR argument and peer port in the peer_port PORT argument.

A FOU or GUE receive port is deleted by specifying PORT in the delete command, as well as local address/interface or peer address/port (if set).

EXAMPLES

Configure a FOU receive port for GRE bound to 7777

```
# ip fou add port 7777 ipproto 47
```

Configure a FOU receive port for IPIP bound to 8888

```
# ip fou add port 8888 ipproto 4
```

Configure a GUE receive port bound to 9999

```
# ip fou add port 9999 gue
```

Delete the GUE receive port bound to 9999

```
# ip fou del port 9999
```

Configure a FOU receive port for GRE bound to 1.2.3.4:7777

```
# ip fou add port 7777 ipproto 47 local 1.2.3.4
```
