NAME

iw - show / manipulate wireless devices and their configuration

SYNOPSIS

iw [OPTIONS] { help [command] | OBJECT COMMAND }

OBJECT := { dev | phy | reg }

OPTIONS := { --version | --debug }

OPTIONS

--version

print version information and exit.

--debug

enable netlink message debugging.

IW - COMMAND SYNTAX

OBJECT

dev <interface name>

- network interface.

phy <phy name>

- wireless hardware device (by name).

phy#<phy index>

- wireless hardware device (by index).

reg - regulatory agent.

COMMAND

Specifies the action to perform on the object. The set of possible actions depends on the object type. `iw help` will print all supported commands, while `iw help com?mand` will print the help for all matching commands.
