laptop-detect [-h|--help|-v|--verbose|-V|--version|-D|--debug]

DESCRIPTION

Laptop-detect attempts to determine whether it is being run on a laptop or a desktop and appraises its caller of this.

OPTIONS

-h --help

Output help information and exit.

-v --verbose

be verbose (messages go to STDOUT)

-V --version

Output version information and exit.

-D --debug

Debug mode.

EXIT STATUS

- 0 most likely running on a laptop
- 1 most likely NOT running on a laptop
- 2 usage error (arguments supplied)
