#### NAME

pam\_localuser - require users to be listed in /etc/passwd

#### **SYNOPSIS**

pam\_localuser.so [debug] [file=/path/passwd]

#### DESCRIPTION

pam\_localuser is a PAM module to help implementing site-wide login policies, where they typically include a subset of the network's users and a few accounts that are local to a particular workstation. Using pam\_localuser and pam\_wheel or pam\_listfile is an effective way to restrict access to either local users and/or a subset of the network's users.

This could also be implemented using pam\_listfile.so and a very short awk script invoked by cron, but it's common enough to have been separated out.

#### OPTIONS

#### debug

Print debug information.

#### file=/path/passwd

Use a file other than /etc/passwd.

## MODULE TYPES PROVIDED

All module types (account, auth, password and session) are provided.

#### **RETURN VALUES**

#### PAM\_SUCCESS

The new localuser was set successfully.

#### PAM\_BUF\_ERR

Memory buffer error.

#### PAM\_CONV\_ERR

The conversation method supplied by the application failed to obtain the username.

#### PAM\_INCOMPLETE

The conversation method supplied by the application returned PAM\_CONV\_AGAIN.

#### PAM\_SERVICE\_ERR

The user name is not valid or the passwd file is unavailable.

# PAM\_PERM\_DENIED

The user is not listed in the passwd file.

#### EXAMPLES

Add the following lines to /etc/pam.d/su to allow only local users or group wheel to use

su.

account sufficient pam\_localuser.so

account required pam\_wheel.so

#### /etc/passwd

Local user account information.
