**NAME**

select-editor - select your default sensible-editor from all installed editors

**SYNOPSIS**

select-editor

**DESCRIPTION**

select-editor provides a coherent mechanism for selecting and storing a preferred sensible-editor on a per-user basis. It lists the available editors on a system and interactively prompts the user to select one. The results are stored as SELECTED\_EDITOR variable in ~/.selected\_editor, which is sourced and used by sensible-editor command. SELECTED\_EDITOR variable is overridden by the VISUAL and EDITOR environment variables.
