PowerShell Get-Help on command 'Get-VpnConnectionTrigger'

PS C:\Users\wahid> Get-Help Get-VpnConnectionTrigger

NAME

Get-VpnConnectionTrigger

SYNOPSIS

Gets trigger properties of a VPN connection.

SYNTAX

```
Get-VpnConnectionTrigger [-ConnectionName] <String> [-AsJob] [-CimSession  
<CimSession[]>] [-ThrottleLimit <Int32>] [<CommonParameters>]
```

DESCRIPTION

The Get-VpnConnectionTrigger cmdlet gets trigger properties of a virtual private network (VPN) connection.

PARAMETERS

-AsJob [<SwitchParameter>]

Runs the cmdlet as a background job. Use this parameter to run commands that take a long time to complete.

-CimSession <CimSession[]>

Runs the cmdlet in a remote session or on a remote computer. Enter a computer name or a session object, such as the output of a `New-CimSession` (<https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/p/?LinkId=227967>) or `[Get-CimSession](https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/p/?LinkId=227966)cmdlet`. The default is the current session on the local computer.

-ConnectionName <String>

Specifies the name of a VPN connection profile. To view existing VPN connection profiles, use the `Get-VpnConnection` cmdlet.

-ThrottleLimit <Int32>

Specifies the maximum number of concurrent operations that can be established to run the cmdlet. If this parameter is omitted or a value of ``0`` is entered, then Windows PowerShell calculates an optimum throttle limit for the cmdlet based on the number of CIM cmdlets that are running on the computer. The throttle limit applies only to the current cmdlet, not to the session or to the computer.

<CommonParameters>

This cmdlet supports the common parameters: `Verbose`, `Debug`, `ErrorAction`, `ErrorVariable`, `WarningAction`, `WarningVariable`, `OutBuffer`, `PipelineVariable`, and `OutVariable`. For more information, see `about_CommonParameters` (<https://go.microsoft.com/fwlink/?LinkID=113216>).

---- Example 1: Get trigger properties of a VPN connection ----

```
PS C:\> Get-VpnConnectionTrigger -ConnectionName "ContosoVPN"
```

```
ConnectionName:      Contoso
```

```
ApplicationID:       {microsoft.windowsphotos_8wekyb3d8bbwe,  
C:\Windows\System32\WindowsPowerShell\v1.0\powershell.exe}
```

TrustedNetwork: {newyork.contoso.com, washington.contoso.com}

This command gets the trigger properties of the VPN connection named ContosoVPN.
