Uninstall-ProvisioningPackage

SYNOPSIS

Uninstalls .PPKG package from the local machine.

SYNTAX

Uninstall-ProvisioningPackage -AllInstalledPackages [-ConnectedDevice]
[-LogsDirectoryPath <String>] [-WprpFile <String>] [<CommonParameters>]

Uninstall-ProvisioningPackage [-PackageId] <String> [-ConnectedDevice]
[-LogsDirectoryPath <String>] [-WprpFile <String>] [<CommonParameters>]

DESCRIPTION

Uninstalls .PPKG package based on package ID, path, metadata, or all packages.

The Uninstall-ProvisioningPackage cmdlet is supported on Windows 11 client operating system only.

PARAMETERS

-AllInstalledPackages [<SwitchParameter>]

Removes all installed packages.

-ConnectedDevice [<SwitchParameter>]

If enabled, specifies that the device type is mobile.

-LogsDirectoryPath <String>

Specifies the logs directory path.

-PackageId <String>

Specifies the ID of a package.

-PackagePath <String>

Specifies the package path.

-RuntimeMetadata <RuntimeProvPackageMetadata>

Specifies a runtime provisioning package metadata object.

-WprpFile <String>

Specifies the location of the WPR profile file.

<CommonParameters>

This cmdlet supports the common parameters: Verbose, Debug, ErrorAction, ErrorVariable, WarningAction, WarningVariable,

```
PS C:\> Uninstall-ProvisioningPackage -AllInstalledPackages
```
