#### NAME

buildah-rm - Removes one or more working containers.

#### SYNOPSIS

buildah rm [container ...]

#### DESCRIPTION

Removes one or more working containers, unmounting them if necessary.

#### OPTIONS

--all, -a

All Buildah containers will be removed. Buildah containers are denoted with an '\*' in the 'BUILDER' column listed by the command 'buildah containers'. A container name or id cannot be provided when this option is used.

#### EXAMPLE

buildah rm containerID

buildah rm containerID1 containerID2 containerID3

buildah rm --all
