INSTANCE can be either the numeric instance ID or the application ID of a running Flatpak. You can use flatpak ps to find the instance IDs of running flatpaks. **OPTIONS** The following options are understood: -h, --help Show help options and exit. -v, --verbose Print debug information during command processing. --ostree-verbose Print OSTree debug information during command processing. **EXAMPLES** \$ flatpak kill org.gnome.Todo
