### **DESCRIPTION**

maddress objects are multicast addresses.

ip maddress show - list multicast addresses

dev NAME (default)

the device name.

ip maddress add - add a multicast address

ip maddress delete - delete a multicast address

These commands attach/detach a static link-layer multicast ad?

dress to listen on the interface. Note that it is impossible to

join protocol multicast groups statically. This command only

manages link-layer addresses.

address LLADDRESS (default)

the link-layer multicast address.

dev NAME
