## DESCRIPTION

nl-classid-lookup searches the classid database for a matching entry.

It is used to resolve qdisc/class names to classid values and vice

versa.

## OPTIONS

-h or --help

Print help text to console and exit.

#### -v or --version

Print versioning information to console and exit.

#### -r or --reverse

Do a reverse lookup. Lookup a classid and print its name.

--raw Print the raw classid in hexadecimal format, do not pretty print

it.

## USAGE

Resolve the qdisc/class name "interactive":

# nl-classid-lookup interactive

Lookup the name of classid 1:2:

# nl-classid-lookup -r 1:2
