\$ man ostree-admin-init-fs.1

OSTREE ADMIN INIT-F(1) ostree admin init-fs OSTREE ADMIN INIT-F(1)

NAME

ostree-admin-init-fs - Initialize a new root filesystem

SYNOPSIS

ostree admin init-fs [OPTIONS...] {PATH}

DESCRIPTION

Initialize an empty physical root filesystem in the designated PATH, with normal toplevels and correct permissions for each directory.

Primarily useful for operating system installers.

EXAMPLE

```
$ mkdir /example
```

```
$ ostree admin init-fs /example
```

```
$ ls /example
```

```
boot dev home ostree proc root run sys tmp
```
