podman-tag(1) General Commands Manual podman-tag(1)

NAME

podman-tag - Add an additional name to a local image

SYNOPSIS

podman tag image[:tag] [target-name[:tag]...] [options]

podman image tag image[:tag] [target-name[:tag]...] [options]

DESCRIPTION

Assigns a new image name to an existing image. A full name refers to the entire image name, including the optional tag after the `:`. If there is no tag provided, then podman will default to latest for both the image and the target-name.

OPTIONS

`--help, -h`

Print usage statement

EXAMPLES

```
$ podman tag 0e3bbc2 fedora:latest
```

```
$ podman tag httpd myregistryhost:5000/fedora/httpd:v2
```
