NAME

podman-volume-mount - Mount a volume filesystem

#### **SYNOPSIS**

podman volume mount [volume ...]

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Mounts the specified volumes' file system in a location which can be accessed from the host, and returns its location.

Rootless mode only supports mounting file volumes unless Podman is run within the user namespace via the podman unshare command. All other volume types will fail to mount.

### RETURN VALUE

The location of the mounted file system. On error an empty string and errno is returned.

#### **EXAMPLE**

podman volume mount foo

/home/dwalsh/.local/share/containers/storage/volumes/foo/\_data
