NAME

projid - the project name mapping file

DESCRIPTION

The /etc/projid file provides a mapping between numeric project identifiers and a simple human readable name (similar relationship to the one that exists between usernames and uids). Its format is simply:

```
# comments are hash-prefixed
```

```
# ...
```

```
cage:10
```

```
logfiles:42
```

This file is optional, if a project identifier cannot be mapped to a name, it will be parsed and displayed as a numeric value.
