RNANO(1) General Commands Manual RNANO(1)

NAME

rnano - a restricted nano

SYNOPSIS

rnano [options] [[+line[,column]] file]...

DESCRIPTION

rnano runs the nano editor in restricted mode. This allows editing only the specified file or files, and doesn't allow the user access to the filesystem nor to a command shell.

In restricted mode, nano will:

- ? not allow suspending;
- ? not allow saving the current buffer under a different name;
- ? not allow inserting another file or opening a new buffer;
- ? not allow appending or prepending to any file;
- ? not make backup files nor do spell checking.

OPTIONS

-h, --help

Show the available command-line options and exit.

For all existing options, see the nano(1) man page.
