#### **NAME**

runc-delete - delete any resources held by the container

## **SYNOPSIS**

runc delete [--force|-f] container-id

#### **OPTIONS**

--force|-f

Forcibly delete the running container, using SIGKILL signal(7) to stop it first.

## **EXAMPLES**

If the container id is ubuntu01 and runc list currently shows its sta?

tus as stopped, the following will delete resources held for ubuntu01,
removing it from the runc list:

# runc delete ubuntu01
