NAME

showconsolefont - Show the current EGA/VGA console screen font

SYNOPSIS

showconsolefont [-V | --version] [-v] [-i] [-C console]

DESCRIPTION

The showconsolefont command outputs the current console font to stdout.

The option -v prints additional information, while the option -V prints the program version number. The option -i doesn't print out the font table, just shows ROWSxCOLSxCOUNT and exits. On Linux 2.6.1 and later, the option -C allows one to indicate the console involved. Its argument is a pathname.
