### **NAME**

systemd-modules-load.service, systemd-modules-load - Load kernel

modules at boot

### **SYNOPSIS**

systemd-modules-load.service

/usr/lib/systemd/systemd-modules-load

### **DESCRIPTION**

systemd-modules-load.service is an early boot service that loads kernel modules. It reads static configuration from files in /usr/ and /etc/, but also runtime configuration from /run/ and the kernel command line (see below).

See modules-load.d(5) for information about the configuration format of this service and paths where configuration files can be created.

### **KERNEL COMMAND LINE**

systemd-modules-load.service understands the following kernel command

line parameters:

modules\_load=, rd.modules\_load=

Takes a comma-separated list of kernel modules to statically load during early boot. The option prefixed with "rd." is read in the initrd only.
