## **DESCRIPTION**

update-gtk-immodules is a wrapper around gtk-query-immodules-2.0 that

tries to help with multilib installations. It is meant to be used in

%post scripts of rpm packages that install input method modules for

GTK+ 2.x.

It needs to be given a GNU-style host triplet as argument, such as

"x86\_64-redhat-linux-gnu". This argument determines where the tool

saves the gtk.immodules file that it creates. It must be the same as

the host triplet that GTK+ was configured with.
