NAME

update-mime-database - a program to build the Shared MIME-Info database cache

SYNOPSIS

update-mime-database -h | -v | [-V | -n] MIME-DIR

DESCRIPTION

update-mime-database is a program which is responsible for updating the shared mime-info cache according to the system described in the Shared MIME-Info Database specification

OPTIONS

- -h Print out a command summary.
- -v Print out the version information.
- -V Be verbose.
- Only update if MIME-DIR/packages/ or a file in that directory is newer than MIME-DIR/version. This is useful for package pre- and post-installation scripts.

MIME-DIR
