bundle doctor [--quiet] [--gemfile=GEMFILE]

#### **DESCRIPTION**

Checks your Gemfile and gem environment for common problems. If issues

are detected, Bundler prints them and exits status 1. Otherwise,

Bundler prints a success message and exits status 0.

Examples of common problems caught by bundle-doctor include:

- ? Invalid Bundler settings
- ? Mismatched Ruby versions
- ? Mismatched platforms
- ? Uninstalled gems
- ? Missing dependencies

## **OPTIONS**

--quiet

--gemfile=<gemfile>

The location of the Gemfile(5) which Bundler should use. This defaults to a Gemfile(5) in the current working directory. In general, Bundler will assume that the location of the Gemfile(5) is also the project?s root and will try to find Gemfile.lock and vendor/cache relative to this location.
