gvfsd-fuse - Fuse daemon for gvfs

gvfsd-fuse PATH

DESCRIPTION

gvfsd-fuse maintains a fuse mount to make gvfs backends available to

POSIX applications. The mount point for the fuse filesystem is provided

by the [PATH] argument.

gvfsd-fuse is normally started by gvfsd(1). In this case, the mount

point is \$XDG_RUNTIME_DIR/gvfs or \$HOME/.gvfs.

OPTIONS

-d

Enable fuse debug output. This implies -f.

-f

Run in the foreground.

-s

Run single-threaded.

-0 OPTION

Set a fuse-specific option. See the fuse documentation for a list

of these.

EXIT STATUS

On success 0 is returned, a non-zero failure code otherwise.
