NAME

jose-b64-enc - Encodes binary data to URL-safe Base64

SYNOPSIS

jose b64 enc -I BIN [-o B64]

OVERVIEW

The jose b64 enc command encodes binary data to URL-safe Base64 format.

OPTIONS

- ? -I FILE, --binary=FILE : Read binary data from FILE
- ? -I -, --binary=- : Read binary data from standard input
- ? -o FILE, --base64=FILE : Write Base64 (URL-safe) to FILE
- ? -o -, --base64=- : Write Base64 (URL-safe) to standard output

EXAMPLES

Encode a simple message:

```
$ echo "Hello, World" | jose b64 enc -I-
```

```
SGVsbG8sIFdvcmxkCg
```
