Iprm cancels print jobs that have been queued for printing. If no ar? guments are supplied, the current job on the default destination is canceled. You can specify one or more job ID numbers to cancel those jobs or use the - option to cancel all jobs.

OPTIONS

The lprm command supports the following options:

- -E Forces encryption when connecting to the server.
- -P destination[/instance]Specifies the destination printer or class.
- -U username
