NAME

podman-healthcheck-run - Run a container healthcheck

SYNOPSIS

podman healthcheck run container

DESCRIPTION

Runs the healthcheck command defined in a running container manually.

The resulting error codes are defined as follows:

- ? 0 = healthcheck command succeeded
- ? 1 = healthcheck command failed
- ? 125 = an error has occurred

Possible errors that can occur during the healthcheck are: * unable to

find the container * container has no defined healthcheck * container

is not running
