#### NAME

semodule\_link - Link SELinux policy module packages together

#### SYNOPSIS

semodule\_link [-Vv] [-o outfile] basemodpkg modpkg1 [modpkg2]...

#### DESCRIPTION

semodule\_link is a developer tool for manually linking together a set of SELinux policy module packages into a single policy module package.

This tool is not necessary for normal operation of SELinux. In normal operation, such linking is performed internally by libsemanage in response to semodule commands. Module packages are created by semodule\_package.

#### OPTIONS

- V show version
- v verbose mode
- o <output file>
