showconsolefont [-V | --version ] [-v ] [-i ] [-C console ]

## **DESCRIPTION**

The showconsolefont command outputs the current console font to stdout.

The option -v prints additional information, while the option -V prints

the program version number. The option -i doesn't print out the font

table, just shows ROWSxCOLSxCOUNT and exits. On Linux 2.6.1 and later,

the option -C allows one to indicate the console involved. Its argument is a pathname.
