## **DESCRIPTION**

LibStorageMgmt simulator C plugin is for development use. The plugin simulates an array which supports most features of the library. The simulator is memory based, state will be discarded once the plugin ex? its. The 'simc\_lsmplugin' executable file is for the libStorageMgmt daemon to execute when client user specifies simc plugin in the URI. Since every command of lsmcli is a standalone libStorageMgmt session, this plugin is essentially useless for this purpose. In this use case, the libStorageMgmt simulator plugin sim\_lsmplugin(1) is suggested. This plugin is written in pure C and is intended to be an example of a C plugin for the library.

simc://
