NAME

ssh-sk-helper ? OpenSSH helper for FIDO authenticator support

SYNOPSIS

ssh-sk-helper [-v]

DESCRIPTION

ssh-sk-helper is used by ssh-agent(1) to access keys provided by a FIDO authenticator.

ssh-sk-helper is not intended to be invoked by the user, but from ssh-agent(1).

A single option is supported:

-v Verbose mode. Causes ssh-sk-helper to print debugging messages

about its progress. This is helpful in debugging problems. Multiple -v options increase the verbosity. The maximum is 3.

Note that `ssh-agent(1)` will automatically pass the -v flag to `ssh-sk-helper` when it has itself been placed in debug mode.
