NAME

vdodmeventd - register/unregister a VDO device with dmeventd

SYNOPSIS

vdodmeventd [options...] vdo

DESCRIPTION

vdodmeventd handles registration/unregistration by specifying vdo which is the name of a VDO device.

OPTIONS

--help Print this help message and exit.

--register

Register a VDO device with dmeventd.

`--unregister`

Unregister a VDO device with `dmeventd`.

`--version`

Show the version of `vdodmevent`.

EXAMPLES

`vdodmeventd --register` is used to register VDO devices.

```
vdodmeventd --register vdo0
```

`vdodmeventd --unregister` is used to unregister VDO devices.

```
vdodmeventd --unregister vdo0
```
