DESCRIPTION

The virtual_image_context file contains a list of image contexts for use by the SELinux-aware virtualization API libvirt (see libvirtd(8)).

selinux_virtual_image_context_path(3) will return the active policy

path to this file. The default virtual image context file is:

/etc/selinux/{SELINUXTYPE}/contexts/virtual_image_context

Where {SELINUXTYPE} is the entry from the selinux configuration file config (see selinux_config(5)).

Each line in the file consists of an entry as follows:

user:role:type[:range]

Where:

user role type range

A user, role, type and optional range (for MCS/MLS) sepa? rated by colons (:) that can be used as a virtual image context.

system_u:object_r:svirt_image_t:s0

system_u:object_r:svirt_content_t:s0
