

NAME

Type::Coercion::FromMoose – a set of coercions borrowed from Moose

STATUS

This module is considered part of Type-Tiny's internals. It is not covered by the Type-Tiny stability policy.

DESCRIPTION

This package inherits from Type::Coercion; see that for most documentation. The major differences are that `add_type_coercions` always throws an exception, and the `type_coercion_map` is automatically populated from Moose.

This is mostly for internal purposes.
