`byobu-reconnect-sockets` – Sourcable script that updates `GPG_AGENT_INFO` and `DBUS_SESSION_BUS_ADDRESS` in the environment

DESCRIPTION

`byobu-reconnect-sockets` is a sourcable bit of shell code that will update the `GPG_AGENT_INFO` and `DBUS_SESSION_BUS_ADDRESS` environment variables in the current shell, such that you may reestablish connection to `gpg-agent(1)` and `dbus-daemon(1)`.

This is often useful when reattaching to a detached Byobu session.
