

NAME

cd-create-profile – Color Manager Profile Creation Tool

SYNOPSIS

cd-create-profile [**--verbose**]

DESCRIPTION

This manual page documents briefly the **cd-create-profile** command.

cd-create-profile allows an administrator to create ICC profiles on their system.

OPTIONS

This program follows the usual GNU command line syntax, with long options starting with two dashes ('-'). A summary of options is included below.

--help

Show summary of options.

--description (optional)

Sets the profile description.

--copyright (optional)

Sets the profile copyright.

--model (optional)

Sets the profile model.

--manufacturer (optional)

Sets the profile manufacturer.

--srgb-palette

Specifies a comma separated values file that is used for the named color.

The format of the CSV file must be "Color Name",0–255(red),0–255(green),0–255(blue).

--output

Specifies the output ICC filename.

--nc-prefix (optional)

Specifies the named color palette prefix.

--nc-suffix (optional)

Specifies the named color palette suffix.
