

NAME

`cryptdisks_start` – wrapper around `cryptsetup` that parses `/etc/crypttab`.

SYNOPSIS

`cryptdisks_start` *<name>*

DESCRIPTION

`cryptdisks_start` is a wrapper around `cryptsetup` that parses `/etc/crypttab` just like the `initscript` `/etc/init.d/cryptdisks` does and starts the `dm-crypt` mapping that corresponds to *<name>*.

Note that this wrapper passes `--key-file=` to `cryptsetup`, so the passphrase in any referenced key file must not be followed by a newline character.
