

**NAME**

dehtmldiff – get usable diff from an HTML page

**SYNOPSIS**

**dehtmldiff** [*file...*]

**dehtmldiff** {[--help] | [--version]}

**DESCRIPTION**

**dehtmldiff** creates usable diff files from HTML pages. This is useful in the scenario where a patch has been posted to a mailing list viewable via a web page.

The corrected diff is sent to standard output. Note that you will probably need to use the **-I** option when applying the patch, in order to ignore any whitespace differences there may be.

**OPTIONS**

**--help**

Display a short usage message.

**--version**

Display the version number of dehtmldiff.

**LIMITATIONS**

The way this command works is fairly primitive; it boils down to some simple text replacements, followed by an **unwrapdiff** pass. As a result, all of the limitations that apply to **unwrapdiff** also apply to **dehtmldiff**.
