

**NAME**

gemtopnm - convert a GEM .img file into a portable anymap

**SYNOPSIS**

**gemtopnm** [-d] [*gemfile*]

**DESCRIPTION**

Reads a GEM .img file, either the one plane (black/white) or four plane (16 color) variety, as input. Reads from stdin if input file is omitted. Produces a PBM or PPM file as output, depending on whether the input is one or four plane.

**OPTIONS**

**-d**      Produce output describing the contents of the .img file.
