geteltorito – an El Torito boot image extractor

## **SYNOPSIS**

**geteltorito** <image | device > [-o outputfile]

## **DESCRIPTION**

**geteltorito** is a Perl script which extracts the initial/default **El Torito** boot image from a CD if one exists. It will not extract any of other boot images that are allowed by the El Torito standard.

The boot image file is written to **stdout** and all other information (e.g., image type and size) is written to **stderr**. To write the image to a file instead of **stdout**, specify the output filename using **–o** *filename*.
