**getpcaps** – display process capabilities

**SYNOPSIS**

**getpcaps**[optional args] *pid*...

**DESCRIPTION**

**getpcaps** displays the capabilities on the processes indicated by the *pid* value(s) given on the command-line. The capabilities are displayed in the **cap\_from\_text(3)** format.

Optional arguments:

**--help** or **--usage** Displays usage information and exits.

**--ugly** or **--legacy** Displays output in a somewhat ugly legacy format.

**--verbose** Displays usage in a legacy-like format but not quite so ugly in modern default terminal fonts.
