

**NAME**

`grub-set-default` – set the saved default boot entry for GRUB

**SYNOPSIS**

`grub-set-default` [*OPTION*] *MENU\_ENTRY*

**DESCRIPTION**

Set the default boot menu entry for GRUB. This requires setting `GRUB_DEFAULT=saved` in `/etc/default/grub`.

**-h, --help**

print this message and exit

**-V, --version**

print the version information and exit

**--boot-directory=DIR**

expect GRUB images under the directory `DIR/grub` instead of the `/boot/grub` directory

`MENU_ENTRY` is a number, a menu item title or a menu item identifier.
