overlayroot-chroot [COMMAND [ARG]...]

DESCRIPTION

overlayroot-chroot is a program that sets up bind mounts for */proc*, */run*, and */sys*, remounts the lower directory in an overlayfs with write capabilities and will **chroot**(8) into it. Upon exit, the bind mounts are unmounted.

Any [COMMAND [ARG]...] are passed directly through to **chroot**(8).
